Your Personal Data

Pangbourne Choral Society is committed to protecting your personal data and will use any personal or sensitive data we collect from you in line with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).

What data do we collect from members?

When you join Pangbourne Choral Society as a member, or during your membership with us, we may need to collect some of the following information about you:

- Name
- Address
- Phone number
- Email address
- Record of Gift Aid declaration
- Voice part (soprano, alto, tenor or bass)
- Rehearsal attendance record

What do we use it for?

We collect data from members to help us plan, organise and run the day-to-day operations of the Society (e.g. co-ordinating rehearsals or collecting subscription payments) and to promote the Society's activities to its members.

From time to time we might wish to make you aware of local events that are not directly related to the Society, but which we consider to be of interest to our members. We generally include event details in emails below other information that is of more direct interest to you as a member. We ask your consent to do this, and you can withdraw such consent at any point by contacting the Data Protection Officer (see below).

How long we will hold your data?

Our data retention policy is to keep records for no longer than is necessary to meet the intended use for which it was gathered, and to remove data within a reasonable period where we no longer have a legitimate reason to keep it.

Where you have withdrawn your consent for us to use your data for a particular purpose (e.g. unsubscribed from a mailing list) we may retain some of your data for a reasonable period in order to preserve a record of your consent having been withdrawn.

Do we share your data with anyone else?

We will never pass your details on to third parties for marketing purposes.

What can you ask us to do?

You can contact us at any time at membership@pangbournechoral.org.uk to view, update or correct the data that we hold about you.

What will we do if anything changes?

If we make changes to our privacy notices or processes we will update our members. Where required by law, will we ask for your consent to continue processing your data after these changes are made.
